Is Turkey planning to intervene in northern Syria?

Turkey has yet to draw the conclusion of the failure of its current strategy: In the race for northern Aleppo, Ankara’s allies are clearly not frontrunners. Faced with such a reality, Turkey will have to increase its support for the Syrian opposition, either in the form of an actual ground operation, which seems risky in light of the Russian air operations above the Aleppo province, or indirectly by providing more artillery support and sending “volunteers” to the border area.
