



---


- Stabilization and development of Pakistan
- Ensure active Pakistani participation in the anti-terrorism campaign
- Enlist Pakistan in effective non-proliferation efforts



# Means

---


- Diplomatic:
  - Washington elevated Pakistan to leading non-NATO ally
  - G-8 Initiative for the Broader Middle East and North Africa
- Security assistance programs
- Development assistance programs



# Security Assistance

---


- Military—1/2 of US assistance through the Foreign Military Financing Funds program
- Trans-national crime programs
  - Roads, vehicles, aircraft
  - Guard outposts
  - Intelligence sharing
  - Police training
- Kashmir
  - Support composite dialogue
  - Support Pakistani efforts to end infiltration of terrorists



# Development Assistance

---


- Debt relief
  - Debt rescheduling
  - Debt forgiveness
- Education programs
  - Focus on primary education-Sindh, Balochistan provinces
  - New emphasis on vocational training

---


- Health programs

---


- Democracy assistance
  - Legislative strengthening
  - Independent media

  - Micro-credit and micro-finance services to the rural economy-Sindh, Balochistan provinces

# Future Aid Package, 2005-2009

---

- Total: \$3 billion for 5 years/\$600 million per year
  - \$300 million for the military
  - \$300 million for economic and social development
    - Of that \$200 million for budget support linked to Pakistan's PRSP
